Extension of the Agreement with the Integrity Commissioner

Executive Summary

The contract with the Integrity Commissioner is coming to an end on October 31, 2024, and the Administration wishes to extend the contractual arrangement with the Integrity Commissioner for an additional period of two years until October 31, 2026.

Options and Recommendation

Options

Council has two options:

- 1) Extend the current agreement for a further two years, coinciding with the end of this Council's mandate on October 31, 2026;
- 2) Initiate a call for tenders for other offers of service for the Integrity Commissioner.

Recommendation

Be it resolved that the Council approve Option 1, as stated in Report DG-011-2024.

Background Information and Analysis

Mr. Jean-Jacques LaCombe was appointed Integrity Commissioner on November 1, 2020. Mr. LaCombe acts as a resource for the Council and the Administration in matters of ethics and investigates complaints lodged against Council Members. On October 1, 2024, Mr. LaCombe submitted his offer of services with his fees unchanged until October 31, 2026.

The Administration is satisfied with the services and business relationship with the current Integrity Commissioner. The offer of services remains unchanged in terms of fees for an additional two-year period until October 31, 2026.
